1 WHAT IS

A sebaceous cyst - a sac under the skin that's usually filled with sebum.

COMMON CAUSES

- ✓ Blocked sebaceous gland ducts
- Skin injury or irritation
- ✓ Acne
- ✓ Genetic predisposition
 These cysts often appear on scalp, face, neck, back or upper chest, and are usually painless unless infected.

Procedure Overview:

1. The skin around the cyst is cleaned and numbed with a local anaesthetic.

- 2. A small incision is made over the cyst.
- 3. The entire cyst sac is carefully excised to prevent recurrence.
- 4. The wound is closed with dissolvable sutures ensuring minimal scarring.
- 5. A sterile dressing is applied.

TAPPER CARE: WOUND CARE ADVICE

Proper care after your procedure is key to smooth and quick recovery

POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS:

- ✓ Keep the area dry for the first 24-48 hours
- Gently clean with mild soap and water once advised
- Change dressings daily, or as instructed by your doctor
